## Achievement

Hunsdon JMI School KS2 SATs results 2016

Subject	Percentage attaining 'Expected Standard Achieved'

Spelling and Grammar	100%	72%
Reading, Writing and Mathematics	100%	53%

These are the results of the first Key Stage 2 SATs tests based on the new, much changed, curriculum. The results are very good compared to the National Average.

## Academy Status

As you may have seen in the press there was much publicity on the Government mandate that all schools needed to convert to Academy status (a very distant political memory since Brexit). There followed somewhat of a U-turn on this mandate by the government. Since then School Governing Body has taken a lot of time to consider the information available to come to a consensus on which direction the school should take.

With the information available the Governing body does not feel there is a compelling argument to take up Academy status at this point in time. We feel there are no stand-out positives and that there is significant risk to the balance and ethos of our school. Hunsdon JMI's ethos is good, the achievements are excellent and the finances are sound. We will keep our ears very close to the ground on this subject as the education landscape is changing rapidly at the moment.

We want to make sure we are in the best position to provide an outstanding education for our pupils.
